A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend chapter 6 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-152, 12-17, 13-54, 16-14, and 16-66, by creating a new subchapter XVIII under chapter 6 to establish a Fishing Fee Revolving Fund, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 6 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated
- 2 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-153, 12-17,
- 3 13-54, 16-14 and 16-66, is hereby further amended by creating a new
- 4 subchapter XVIII under chapter 6 entitled "Fishing Fee Revolving
- 5 Fund."
- 6 Section 2. Chapter 6 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated
- 7 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-153, 12-17,
- 8 13-54, 16-14 and 16-66, is hereby further amended by inserting a
- 9 new section 1801 to subchapter XVIII of chapter 6, to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 "Section 1801. Establishment. There is hereby created and
- 12 established a Fishing Fee Revolving Fund, separate from the
- 13 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia and all
- 14 <u>other funds</u>."
- 15 Section 3. Chapter 6 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated
- 16 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-153, 12-17,
- 17 13-54, 16-14 and 16-66, is hereby further amended by inserting a
- 18 new section 1802 to subchapter XVIII of chapter 6, to read as

1 follows: 2 "Section 1802. Purpose. The purpose of the Fund is to 3 increase transparency of amounts and destinations of fishing fee revenues." 4 Section 4. Chapter 6 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated 5 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-153, 12-17, 6 7 13-54, 16-14 and 16-66, is hereby further amended by inserting a new section 1803 to subchapter XVIII of chapter 6, to read as 9 follows: "Section 1803. Deposits. All proceeds collected upon any 10 11 agreement, license, or other arrangement entered into 12 pursuant to Title 24 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia shall be deposited into the Fund Any unexpended 13 14 moneys in this Fund shall neither revert to the General Fund 15 nor lapse at the end of the fiscal year, but shall remain in the Fund until disbursed pursuant to section 1805 of this 16 17 subchapter." Section 5. Chapter 6 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated 18 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-153, 12-17, 19 13-54, 16-14 and 16-66, is hereby further amended by inserting a 20 21 new section 1804 to subchapter XVIII of chapter 6, to read as 22 follows: 23 "Section 1804. Administration. The fund shall be administered by the President of the Federated States of 24

Micronesia, or his designee, who shall establish procedures

1	necessary and appropriate for the effectuation and
2	implementation of the provisions of this subchapter."
3	Section 6. Chapter 6 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated
4	States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-153, 12-17,
5	13-54, 16-14 and 16-66, is hereby further amended by inserting a
6	new section 1805 to subchapter XVIII of chapter 6, to read as
7	follows:
8	"Section 1805. Disbursements.
9	(1) Disbursements shall be made quarterly. No
10	disbursement shall be made from the Fund except in
11	accordance with the provisions of this section.
12	(2) Disbursement Formula.
13	(a) Twenty (20) percent of all deposits to the Fund
14	shall be disbursed to the four FSM states in amounts to be
15	determined by a formula designated in a Memorandum of
16	Understanding between the National and State governments.
17	(b) Twenty (20) percent of all deposits shall be
18	transferred into the FSM Trust Fund created under Chapter
19	12 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
20	Micronesia.
21	(c) Sixty (60) percent of all deposits shall be
22	transferred to the General Fund created by section 208 of
23	title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
24	Micronesia."
