A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 5, 6, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-28, 17-31, and 17-49, in order to appropriate \$2,850,714 of supplemental funding for fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended 2 by Public Laws Nos. 17-28 and 17-31, is hereby further amended 3 to read as follows:

Purpose. The purpose of this act is to 4 "Section 1. appropriate the sum of $\{\frac{45,327,053}{48,177,767}, or$ 5 so much thereof as may be necessary, from the 6 7 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia 8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for the purpose of funding the operations of all 9 branches of the National Government of the Federated 10 States of Micronesia, its agencies, various 11 12 programs, grants, subsidies and contributions. Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein, 13 \$4,437,560 shall be deemed to come from funds 14 available under the amended Compact from the 15 education sector subject to the receipt of Grant 16 17 Awards under the amended Compact; \$1,176,656 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the 18 19 Supplemental Education Grant; \$878,750 shall be

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1 deemed to come from funds available under the amended 2 Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt 3 of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$329,598 shall be deemed to come from funds available under 4 the amended Compact from the capacity building 5 sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds 6 available under the amended Compact from the private 7 8 sector development sector; and \$1,194,212 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the 9 amended Compact from the infrastructure sector. 10 11 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended 12 by Public Law No. 17-28, is hereby further amended to read as 13 follows: 14 Section 5. Operating Expenses of the National Public 15 Auditor. The sum of \$883,391, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the 16 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia 17 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for 18 the operations of the National Office of the Public 19 Auditor and for the National Public Auditor's Chuuk 20 21 Office.
