A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 12-50, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 12-53, 12-74, 13-1, 13-17, 14-65, 14-71, 14-94, 15-15, 15-50 and 17-24, by amending section 13 thereof, to change the use of funds for the purpose of funding Pattiw Junior High School land purchase and related expenses, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
