A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1 and 9 of Public Law No. 17-64, to appropriate \$600,000 of supplemental funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013 s matching funds to support the Tax Reform IT automation project; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this act is to
- 2 appropriate the sum of $\{\frac{40,491,992}{2}\}$ $\frac{41,091,992}{2}$, or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary, from the General Fund of the
- 4 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
- 5 September 30, 2013, for the purpose of funding the operations
- 6 of all branches of the National Government of the Federated
- 7 States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,
- 8 subsidies and contributions, and Capital and Human Resources
- 9 Development. Of the total amount of funds appropriated
- 10 herein, \$4,252,868 shall be deemed to come from funds
- 11 available under the amended Compact from the education sector
- 12 subject to the receipt of Grant Awards under the amended
- 13 Compact; \$1,067,875 shall be deemed to come from funds
- 14 available under the Supplemental Education Grant; \$895,705
- 15 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended
- 16 Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt of Grant
- 17 Awards under the amended Compact; \$-0- shall be deemed to come
- 18 from funds available under the amended Compact from the
- 19 capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from

- 1 funds available under the amended Compact from the private
- 2 sector development sector; \$157,450 shall be deemed to come
- 3 from funds available under the amended Compact from the
- 4 enhanced reporting and accountability sector; and \$283,245
- 5 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended
- 6 Compact from the infrastructure sector.
- 7 Section 2. Section 9 of Public Law No. 17-64 is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 Section 9. <u>Capital and Human Resources Development</u>.
- 10 The sum of $\{[8,020,294]$ 8,620,294, or so much thereof as may be
- 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
- 12 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
- 13 September 30, 2013, for the following capital improvements,
- 14 development programs, and projects and human resources
- 15 development. Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein,
- 16 \$3,100,000 shall be deemed to come from funds available under
- 17 the amended Compact from the education sector subject to the
- 18 receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$683,346
- 19 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
- 20 Supplemental Education Grant; \$390,000 shall be deemed to come
- 21 from funds available under the amended Compact from the health
- 22 sector; and \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available
- 23 under the amended Compact from the capacity building sector.
