A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26 and 15-33, 15-43, 15-45, 15-49, 15-55 and 15-65 by further amending section 8 thereof, to modify the use of funds previously appropriated therein from the General Fund for fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 8 of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended
- 2 by Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26, 15-43 and 15-45, is hereby
- 3 further amended to read as follows:

- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General
- 7 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the

- 10 fiscal year 2008. Of the total amount of funds
- appropriated herein, \$2,777,710 shall be deemed to
- come from funds available under the amended Compact
- 13 for Capacity Building, PROVIDED THAT these funds
- 14 shall not be allocated or obligated until such time
- as formal approval has been obtained with the Amended
- 16 Compact of Free Association. The sum appropriated by
- 17 this section shall be apportioned as follows:
