A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$6,712,612 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, by amending sections 1, 2, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-69 and 17-74, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended by
Public Laws Nos. 17-69 and 17-74, is hereby further amended to
read as follows:
