A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia supplemental funding in the total amount of \$148,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, by amending sections 1, 2 and 8 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-48, 16-53, 16-60, 16-65, 16-70 and 17-01, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
