14	by Public Law No. 17-05, is hereby further amended to read as
15	follows:
16	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
17	lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
18	be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for
19	in accordance with applicable law, including, but not
20	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
21	The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that
22	these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
23	are used solely for the purpose specified in this
24	act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
25	of the sum appropriated. The allottee of funds

appropriated under sections 2 and 4 of this act shall 1 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, PROVIDED THAT the 3 4 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(c) of this act shall be the Pohnpei 5 Transportation Authority, [T] the allottee of funds 6 7 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c) of this act 8 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Resources and Development or his designee, the allottee of 9 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(b), 4(3)(c) 10 and 4(3)(j) of this act shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of 11 12 Kitti Municipal Government and the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(i) of this act 13 shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw 14 Municipal Government. The allottee of funds 15 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the 16 17 Governor of Yap State. The allottee of funds 18 appropriated under subsections 5(1)(2)(4)(5) and (6) shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement 19 Project (CSCIP). The allottee of funds appropriated 20 under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the 21 22 Executive Director of the Northern Namoneas Social and Economic Development Authority. The funds 23 24 appropriated by this act shall remain available until fully expended." 25
