## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 17-19, by amending sections 1 and 8, as amended by Public Law No. 17-28, in order to appropriate supplemental funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, to cover the necessary expenditures in holding a state and national leadership conference; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended 1 2 by Public Law No. 17-28, is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the sum of \$[45,277,053] 45,323,053, or 4 5 so much thereof as may be necessary, from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia 6 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for 7 the purpose of funding the operations of all 8 branches of the National Government of the Federated 9 States of Micronesia, its agencies, various 10 programs, grants, subsidies and contributions. Of 11 the total amount of funds appropriated herein, 12 13 \$4,437,560 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the 14 education sector subject to the receipt of Grant 15 Awards under the amended Compact; \$1,176,656 shall 16 17 be deemed to come from funds available under the Supplemental Education Grant; \$878,750 shall be 18

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deemed to come from funds available under the amended 1 2 Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt 3 of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$329,598 shall be deemed to come from funds available under 4 the amended Compact from the capacity building 5 sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds 6 available under the amended Compact from the private 7 8 sector development sector; and \$1,194,212 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the 9 amended Compact from the infrastructure sector. 10 11 Section 2. Section 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended 12 by Public Law No. 17-28, is hereby amended to read as follows: 13 "Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions. 14 The sum of \$[<del>9,476,230</del>] <u>9,522,230</u>, or so much 15 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of 16 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 17 2012, for the following grants, subsidies and 18 contributions during fiscal year 2012. Of the total 19 amount of funds appropriated herein, \$-0- shall be 20 deemed to come from funds available under the amended 21 22 Compact from the education sector; and \$-0- shall be 23 deemed to come from funds available under the Supplemental Education Grant. The sum appropriated 24 25 by this section shall be apportioned as follows:
