A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2 and 12 of Public Law No. 17-79, as amended by Public Law No. 17-78, to appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia supplemental funding in the amount of \$75,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, to provide medical assistance to Yap State, to create an allottee of funding, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for 2 in accordance with applicable law, including, but not 3 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. 4 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for 5 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may 6 7 be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are 8 incurred in excess of the sums appropriated. 9 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds 10 appropriated by this act are as follows: 11 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds 12 shall be the President of the Federated States of 13 14 Micronesia: (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds 15 16 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia; 17 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds 18 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of 19 the Federated States of Micronesia: 2.0 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds 21 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States 22 of Micronesia: 2.3 2.4 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the Federated 25

1 States of Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this 2. 3 act: (i) Section 8, subsection (13)(a) 4 through (d) - the allottee of these funds shall be 5 the Chief Justice of the respective State Supreme 6 7 Court, (ii) Section 8, subsection (13)(r) - the 8 allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the 9 10 State of Yap, 11 ([iii]iii) Section 9(1)(a) - the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the College 12 of Micronesia-FSM, 13 14 ([iii]iv) Section 9, subsection (12)(a) 15 through (d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the FSM Supreme Court. 16 17 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse 18 as of September 30, 2012; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the 19 2.0 funds appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not lapse; PROVIDED FURTHER, that for the funds 21 appropriated by section 9, subsection (16) of this 22 act, the authority of the allottee to obligate funds 2.3 2.4 shall lapse on December 30, 2011."
