## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1 and 9 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-28 and 17-31, in order to appropriate \$500,000 of supplemental funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended
by Public Laws Nos. 17-28 and 17-31, is hereby amended to read
as follows:

The purpose of this act is to "Section 1. Purpose. 4 appropriate the sum of \$[45,327,053] 45,827,053, or 5 so much thereof as may be necessary, from the 6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia 7 8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for the purpose of funding the operations of all 9 branches of the National Government of the Federated 10 States of Micronesia, its agencies, various 11 12 programs, grants, subsidies and contributions. Of 13 the total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$4,437,560 shall be deemed to come from funds 14 available under the amended Compact from the 15 education sector subject to the receipt of Grant 16 Awards under the amended Compact; \$1,176,656 shall 17 18 be deemed to come from funds available under the 19 Supplemental Education Grant; \$878,750 shall be

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1 deemed to come from funds available under the amended 2 Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$329,598 3 shall be deemed to come from funds available under 4 5 the amended Compact from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds 6 7 available under the amended Compact from the private sector development sector; and \$1,194,212 shall be 8 deemed to come from funds available under the 9 amended Compact from the infrastructure sector." 10 11 Section 2. Section 9 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended 12 by Public Law No. 17-28, is hereby amended to read as follows: 13 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development. The sum of \$[<del>10,216,812</del>] 10,716,812, or so much 14 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated 15 from the General Fund of the Federated States of 16 17 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for the following capital improvements, 18 development programs and projects, and human 19 resources development. Of the total amount of funds 20 appropriated herein, \$3,800,000 shall be deemed to 21 22 come from funds available under the amended Compact from the education sector subject to the receipt of 23 24 Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$683,346 shall be deemed to come from funds available under 25
