Dear Speaker Figir:

I hereby designate as Public Law No. 17-26, the following congressional act which became a public law without my signature:

Congressional Act No. 17-19, "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-18, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 16-24, 16-32, 16-39, 16-45, 16-54, 16-67, 17-04 AND 17-14, BY AMENDING SECTION 1 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS IN THE STATES OF POHNPEI AND CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Among the amendments introduced by this law is a new line item for Chuuk Election District No. 1 called Solar System Project in the amount of \$32,216, which will be funded using leftover funds from existing line items. The Department of Finance has confirmed that at present the leftover funds are insufficient to support the new item. Therefore, I urge Congress to revisit this matter during the next session in order to correct the discrepancy.

#### AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-18, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-24, 16-32, 16-39, 16-45, 16-54, 16-67, 17-04 and 17-14, by amending section 1 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for the purpose of funding Economic and Social Projects and Programs in the States of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-18, as amended
