I have approved the following congressional act to become Public Law No. 17-30 as follows:

Congressional Act No. 17-22, "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-49, BY AMENDING SECTION 5, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 16-68, 16-76 AND 17-06, TO MODIFY THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS IN THE STATE OF CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

In this act, the level of funding previously appropriated for Chuuk public projects and social programs have remained the same. However, certain items have been either decreased or increased, in particular, for Chuuk State at-large and for Election District No. 5.

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-49, by amending section 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-68, 16-76 and 17-06, to modify the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
