Congressional Act No. 17-42, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND SECTION 1 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 15-80, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-04, TO CHANGE THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN FOR PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS IN THE STATE OF CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

This is an amendment of public project for Chuuk to establish new project using leftover of current appropriation.

PUBLIC LAW No. 17-53

AN ACT

To further amend section 1 of Public Law No. 15-80, as amended by Public Law No. 16-04, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-80, as amended
2	by Public Law No. 16-04, is hereby further amended to read as
