PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-06

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-49, by amending sections 4 and 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-68 and 16-76, to modify the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Chuuk and Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
