PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-07

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26, 15-33, 15-43, 15-45, 15-49, 15-55 and 15-65 by further amending section 8 thereof, to modify the use of funds previously appropriated therein from the General Fund for fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 8 of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended
by Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26, 15-43 and 15-45, is hereby

3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions. 5 The sum of \$6,969,942 or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the 7 8 fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, for the 9 following grants, subsidies and contributions during fiscal year 2008. Of the total amount of funds 10 11 appropriated herein, \$2,777,710 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact 12 for Capacity Building, PROVIDED THAT these funds 13 14 shall not be allocated or obligated until such time as formal approval has been obtained with the Amended 15 16 Compact of Free Association. The sum appropriated by 17 this section shall be apportioned as follows: (1) Office of the President. 18
