PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-16

AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia supplemental funding in the total amount of \$213,910 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, by amending sections 1, 2, and 6 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-48, 16-53, 16-60, 16-65, 16-70, and 17-01 and for other purposes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by
Public Laws Nos. 16-48, 16-53, 16-60, 16-65, and 17-01 is
hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to 4 appropriate the sum of \$41,140,756 or so much thereof 5 as may be necessary, from the General Fund of the 6 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year 7 ending September 30, 2011, for the purpose of funding 8 the operations of all branches of the National 9 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its 10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and 11 12 contributions. Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$4,403,240 shall be deemed to 13 14 come from funds available under the amended Compact from the education sector; \$1,178,720 shall be deemed 15 to come from funds available under the Supplemental 16 17 Education Grant; \$868,276 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the 18 health sector; \$808,990 shall be deemed to come from 19

1	funds available under the amended Compact from the
2	capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to
3	come from funds available under the amended Compact
4	from the private sector development sector; and $\$-0-$
5	shall be deemed to come from funds available under
6	the amended Compact from the infrastructure sector."
7	Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended
8	by Public Laws Nos. 16-48, 16-53, 16-60, 16-65, and 17-01 is
9	hereby further amended to read as follows:
10	"Section 2. <u>Operating expenses of the Executive</u>
11	Branch. The sum of \$17,419,207 or so much thereof as
12	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
13	General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
14	for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, for
15	the purpose of funding the operations of the
16	Executive Branch of the National Government during
17	fiscal year 2011. Of the total amount of funds
18	appropriated herein, \$486,729 shall be deemed to come
19	from funds available under the amended Compact from
20	the education sector; \$371,591 shall be deemed to
21	come from funds available under the Supplemental
22	Education Grant; \$668,276 shall be deemed to come
23	from funds available under the amended Compact from
24	the health sector; and -0 - shall be deemed to come
25	from funds available under the amended Compact from

1	the capacity building sector. The sum appropriate	d
