## AN ACT

To further amend sections 1 and 2 of Public Law No. 16-18, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-24, 16-32, 16-39, 16-45, 16-54, 16-67, 17-04, 17-14 and 17-26, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein to fund public project and social programs in the States of Pohnpei and Chuuk, to set the lapse date, and for other purposes.

7	Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 16-18, as amended
8	by Public Laws Nos. 16-24 and 17-14, is hereby further amended
9	to read as follows:
10	"Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
11	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
12	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
13	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
14	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
15	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
16	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
17	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
18	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
19	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
20	under section 1 of this act shall be the President of
21	the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
22	PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
23	sections 1(4)(a), (d), (e) and (f) of this act shall be
24	the Chuuk Commission on Improvement Project (CSCIP) and
25	that the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection

1	1(4)(f)(vi) of this act shall be the President of the
2	College of Micronesia-FSM. The allottee of funds
3	appropriated under section 1(4)(b) of this act shall be
4	the Mortlock Islands Development Authority (MIDA). The
5	allottee of funds appropriated under section 1(1) of
6	this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap. The
7	authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
8	by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2014."
9	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval
10	by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
11	or upon its becoming law without such approval.
