PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-40

AN ACT

To further amend sections 1 and 2 of Public Law No. 15-32, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-36, 15-44, 15-57, 15-63, 15-72, 15-78, 16-03, 16-11, 16-33, 16-46, 17-12, 17-21 and 17-33, to change the use and the allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein for the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-32, as amended
by Public Laws Nos. 15-36, 15-44, 15-57, 15-63, 15-72, 15-78,
16-03, 16-11, 16-33, 16-46, 17-12, 17-21 and 17-33, is hereby
further amended to read as follows:

5	"Section 1. The sum of \$3,780,000, or so much
6	thereof, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
7	of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
8	year ending September 30, 2008, for the purpose of
9	funding public projects and social programs in each
10	State of the Federated States of Micronesia. The
11	fund shall be apportioned on the basis of \$250,000 or
12	less per member of Congress as follows, PROVIDED THAT
13	an increase of \$300,000 is for Yap State.

11	Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 15-32, as amended,					
12	by Public Laws Nos. 15-36, 15-57, 15-63 and 17-21, is hereby					
13	3 further amended to read as follows:					
14	"Section 2. <u>Allotment and management of funds and</u>					
15	lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall					
16	be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for					
17	in accordance with applicable laws, including, but					
18	not limited to the Financial Management Acts of each					
19	of the States, the Financial Management Act of 1979					
20	and the amended Compact of Free Association between					
21	the United States Government and the Government of					
22	the Federated States of Micronesia and its related					
23	agreements. The allottee shall be responsible for					
24	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may					
25	be necessary, are used solely for the purpose					

1	specified in this act, and that no obligations are
2	incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The
3	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
4	(4)(a), (d) , (e) and (f) of section 1 of this act
5	shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement
6	Project EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds
7	appropriated under subsection 1(4)(f)(xii) of section
8	1 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or
9	his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated
10	under subsection 4(b) shall be the Mortlock Islands
11	Development Authority (MIDA). The allottee of funds
12	appropriated under subsections 1 and 3 of section 1
13	of this act shall be the President of the Federated
14	States of Micronesia or his designee, EXCEPT THAT the
15	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
16	(1)(1) of section 1 of this act shall be the Mayor of
17	Tafunsak Municipal Government. The allottee of funds
18	appropriated under subsection 4(c) of section 1 of
19	this act shall be the Executive Director of the
20	Northern Namoneas Social and Economic Development
21	Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
22	subsection (2) of section 1 of this act shall be the
23	Governor of the State of Yap. The funds appropriated
24	by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2013."
