FOURTH REGULAR SESSION, 2012 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 17-138, C.D.1, C.D.2, C.D.3 PC NO. 17-244 PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-52

AN ACT

To further amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-28, 17-31, and 17-49, to appropriate \$1,540,800 of supplemental funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by 2 Public Laws Nos. 17-28 and 17-31, is hereby amended to read as 3 follows:

"Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to 4 appropriate the sum of \$46,867,853, or so much thereof 5 6 as may be necessary, from the General Fund of the 7 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for the purpose of funding 8 the operations of all branches of the National 9 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its 10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and 11 contributions. Of the total amount of funds 12 13 appropriated herein, \$4,437,560 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the 14 education sector subject to the receipt of Grant Awards 15 under the amended Compact; \$1,176,656 shall be deemed to 16 come from funds available under the Supplemental 17 Education Grant; \$878,750 shall be deemed to come from 18 funds available under the amended Compact from the health 19

1 sector subject to the receipt of Grant Awards under the 2 amended Compact; \$329,598 shall be deemed to come from 3 funds available under the amended Compact from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come 4 from funds available under the amended Compact from the 5 private sector development sector; and \$1,194,212 shall 6 be deemed to come from funds available under the amended 7 8 Compact from the infrastructure sector."

9 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by 10 Public Law No. 17-28, is hereby further amended to read as 11 follows:
