PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-81

AN ACT

To further amend section 5 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by Public Law No. 17-71, for the purpose of changing the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by 2 Public Law No. 17-71, is hereby further amended to read as 3 follows: "Section 5.
