PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-84

AN ACT

To further amend sections 3, 4 and 5 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-71 and 17-81, for the purpose of changing the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended 2 by Public Laws Nos. 17-71, is hereby further amended to read as 3 follows:
