Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred Presidential Communication No. 18-228 and Congressional Bill No. 18-131, regarding the veto of Congressional Act No. 18-53, begs leave to report as follows:

Congressional Act No. 18-53 was vetoed by the President and did not become Public Law. The Congressional Act was then referred back to your Committee on Ways and Means.

P.C. No. 18-228 enumerates several grounds for the veto. Your Committee observes that the underlying intention for C.A. No. 18-53 was for the public interest, to recognize the First Speaker of the Congress of Micronesia.

Your Committee has revisited this issue and found the vetoed item is consistent with sound public policy, as the attempt here has already been practiced, and therefore disagrees with the decision to veto.
