This grant provides for the office supplies and pays a portion of the Program Coordinator for HIV prevention, control and support in Chuuk. The detailed two page budget is attached to this report.

The Committee asked in the incidence of HIV was decreasing. The Department stated that it appears to be increasing and that the rate of other sexually transmitted disease is very high in our Nation. The Department stated that this problem is difficult to get a clear picture of as the rates of infection are under reported. The Committee was satisfied that the Department of Health and Social Affairs is undertaking measures to support our individuals with HIV. Related grants for HIV and STD's will be forthcoming soon.

As to the specific grant that is the subject of this report your Committee on Health and Social Affairs is supportive of the program that it will support. Your Committee on Health and Social Affairs is in accord with the intent and purposes of C.R. No. 18-266, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto, subject to the concurrence of the Committee on External Affairs.
