A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 112 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law Nos. 11-81 and 13-64, and by inserting a new section 208 to chapter 2 of title 52 F.S.M.C., to provide for a cost-of-living allowance (COLA) for all of the employees of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 112 of title 52 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law Nos.
- 3 11-81 and 13-64, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 112. <u>Definitions.</u> In this chapter, unless
- 5 the context requires otherwise, the following
- 6 definitions shall apply:
- 7 (1) "Adjusted base salary" means the total of base
- 8 salary plus marketplace premium, foreign service
- 9 premium, professional premium, or cost-of-living
- 10 allowance (COLA). If an employee is not entitled to
- any of these premiums, his adjusted base salary means
- 12 his base salary.
- 13 (2) "Base Salary" means the specific rate of pay for
- 14 a given pay level and step as contained within the
- 15 base salary schedule established by law. "Base
- 16 Salary" does not include premiums under section 163 of
- this chapter, professional premiums, cost-of-living
- 18 allowance (COLA), differentials under section 164 of

this chapter, or transfer, travel per diem, or other 1 2 similar allowances. 3 "Class" or "class of positions" means a group of positions sufficiently similar so that all can 4 reasonably be identified by the same title, be filled 5 by applying the same qualification standards, and be 6 7 equitably compensated by the same salary level. A class may consist of only one position or of any greater number of positions. 9 "cost-of-living allowance (COLA)" means the 10 11 increase in base salary to compensate for loss of 12 purchasing power due to inflation. The COLA increment is not subject to tax or social security contribution. 13 14 $\left[\frac{4}{5}\right]$ "Eligible list" means a list of persons who 15 have been found qualified for appointment to a position in a particular class. Such a list may be 16 17 either reemployment, promotional, or open-competitive. $\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$ (6) "Eliqible person" or "eliqible" means a 18 19 person whose name is on an active eligible list. "Employee" means a person holding a 20 $[\frac{(6)}{(7)}]$ position in the public service, whether permanently or 21 22 otherwise. 23 "Foreign service premium" means a premium $[\frac{7}{1}]$ set forth under subsection 163(2) of this title [to be 24

paid in addition to base salary to employees who are

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1	citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia
2	assigned to permanent duty stations outside the
3	Federated States of Micronesia].
4	$\left[\frac{(8)}{(9)}\right]$ "Government of Federated States of
5	Micronesia" includes the Legislative, the Executive,
6	and the Judicial Branches and the agencies of the
7	Government of Micronesia.
8	$[\frac{(9)}{(10)}]$ "Management official" or "management" means
9	a person authorized to make appointments or changes in
10	status of employees in the public services.
11	[(10)] <u>(11)</u> "Market place premium" means a premium as
12	set forth under subsection 163(1) of this title.
13	$\left[\frac{(11)}{(12)}\right]$ "Open-competitive examination" means an
14	examination for positions in a particular class,
15	admission to which is not limited to persons employed
16	in public service.
17	$\left[\frac{(12)}{(13)}\right]$ "Open-competitive list" means list of
18	persons who have been found qualified by open-
19	competitive examination for appointment to a position
20	in a particular class.
21	$\left[\frac{(13)}{(14)}\right]$ "Personnel officer" means the head of the
22	Office of Personnel of the Government of the Federated
23	States of Micronesia.
24	$\left[\frac{(14)}{(15)}\right]$ "Position" means a group of duties and
25	responsibilities assigned by competent authority to be

performed by one person, working full-time or part-1 2 time. A position may be either occupied or vacant. 3 $\left[\frac{(15)}{(16)}\right]$ (16) "Position classification plan" means the arrangement in a systematic order of the titles of all 4 classes existing in the public service, with a 5 description of each class. 6 7 $[\frac{(16)}{(17)}]$ "Probation period" means a period of probationary employment status of not less than six months nor more than one year from the beginning of an 9 employee's service in a particular position or class 10 11 in the public service. 12 $[\frac{(17)}{(18)}]$ (18) "Professional premium" means a premium as set forth under subsection 163(3) of this title. 13 14 $[\frac{(18)}{(19)}]$ "Promotional examination" means an 15 examination for positions in a particular class, admission to which is limited to regular employees in 16 17 the public service. $[\frac{(19)}{(20)}]$ (20) "Promotional list" means a list of 18 19 persons who have been found qualified by a promotional examination for appointment to a position in a 20 particular class. 21 22 $[\frac{(20)}{(21)}]$ "Public service" means all offices and 23 other positions in the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia not exempted by section 117 of 24 25 this chapter.

1	$\left[\frac{(21)}{(22)}\right]$ "Reemployment list" means a list of
2	persons who have been regular employees in the public
3	service and who are entitled to have their names
4	certified for appointment to a position in the class
5	in which they last held permanent status, or in a
6	related class in the same or a lower salary range for
7	which they meet the qualification requirements.
8	$[\frac{(22)}{(23)}]$ "Regular employee" or "permanent employee"
9	means an employee who has been appointed to a position
10	in the public service who has successfully completed a
11	probation period."
12	Section 2. Title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of
13	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting a
14	new section 208 of chapter 2 to read as follows:
15	"Section 208. Cost-of-living allowance (COLA).
16	All employees of the National Government of the
17	Federated States of Micronesia (including contract and
18	exempt employees) shall receive a cost-of-living
19	allowance (COLA) in the amount of \$40.00 per 80 hour
20	pay period. This COLA shall be in effect from January
21	1, 2015 to December 31, 2017."
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25	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the

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1 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
 2 becoming law without such approval.
