Dear Speaker Halbert:

I am returning the following Congressional Acts to become public laws pursuant to Article IX Section 22 of the FSM Constitution, without my signature:


Public Law No. 18-94: Congressional Act No. 18-103, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-35, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NOS. 18-49, 18-61 AND 18-63, BY AMENDING SECTION 4 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF POHNPEI, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Public Law No. 18-95: Congressional Act No. 18-104, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-68, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 17-71, 17-81, 17-84, 17-89, 17-90, 18-03, 18-10, 18-13, 18-32, 18-46, 18-58 AND 18-87, BY AMENDING SECTION 4 THEREIN, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CHANGING THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATE TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE STATE OF POHNPEI, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

I reiterate that these Congressional Acts, like other appropriations of public projects and social programs, both suffer from fundamental defects. There were no public hearings or consultations held prior to their enactment. No committee reports were ever written on either of the Acts to explain the rationale of the amendments. Based on the timelines of their passage, it is clear that approval of the Acts was rushed.

To illustrate this point, both Acts were referred to the Committee on Ways & Means on September 25th and 26th, respectively, but they were withdrawn from the Committee on September 29, 2014, and passed on first reading on the same day they were withdrawn. There are no records shown to justify their withdrawal from the assigned Committee. On the following day, both Acts passed on second reading. Once again, there are no written records of deliberation ever produced explaining the necessity of the amendments. No valid goals were established that justify the rushed enactments.

For these reasons, both Acts are being returned without signature.

#### PUBLIC LAW No. 18-95

#### AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 17-81, 17-84, 17-89, 17-90, 18-03, 18-10, 18-13, 18-32, 18-46, 18-58 and 18-87, by amending section 4 therein, for the purpose of changing the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs for the State of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by
