Dear Speaker Halbert:

I am pleased to transmit the following congressional act, which I have signed to become Public Law No. 18-122:

Congressional Act No. 18-128: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-70, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 18-98 AND 18-112, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 4, 5, AND 6, THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF POHNPEI AND CHUUK STATES."

The Act amended Section 5 (4) (g) to change the use of the sum of \$50,000 previously authorized for "Community Housing repair/improvement" to be now use for "Individual Housing repair/improvement after the aftermath of Typhoon Maysak."

The rest of the amendments under Section 4 of the Act changed the use of funds and allottee previously authorized and designated under the current law.

I once again express my concerns raised in my previous veto messages over the way Congress appropriates public funds to be expended on public projects and social programs that lacks planning, transparency and accountability. The proprieties and priorities of Congress in public projects appropriations have been highlighted and found by FSM Public Auditor to be lacking of clarity, transparency and accountability and do not yield any meaningful and lasting public benefits that contributes to the future sustainable economic development of this nation.

Having said the above, I, nevertheless, thank Congress for its effort to contribute more funding to assist the victims of Typhoon Maysak in Chuuk.


Dear President Mori:

"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum The allottee of the funds appropriated appropriated. under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State EXCEPT THAT the funds appropriated under subsection 2(i) shall be the President of COM-FSM. The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee EXCEPT THAT the funds appropriated under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h, i, j, k, l, m, n, o, s, t, u, v, w, x and ag, ah and aj of section 3 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the funds appropriate under subsection 4(2)(k) shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town Government; the funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(1) shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs Municipal Government; the funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(m) shall be the Mayor of Nukuoro

Municipal Government; the funds appropriated under
subsections a, b, c, d, e, f and g of section 4(1),
subsection 4(2)(1), subsections 4(3)(b), (c), (d), (f)
and (p) of this act shall the Pohnpei Transportation
Authority, and the funds appropriated under subsection
4(3)(t) shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The
allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(h)
shall be the President of the Federated States of
Micronesia of his designee. The allottee of funds
appropriate under subsection 4(2)(g) of this act shall
be the Administrator of the MiCare program. The
allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(1)
and 5(3) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
State or his designee. The allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be
the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The
allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of
this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
Development Authority. The allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection 5(6) of this act shall be
the General Manager of the Northwest Island Development
Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September

1	30, 2015."
