PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-01

AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$707,338 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-69, 17-72, 17-74 and 17-88, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended by
Public Law No. 17-69, 17-72, 17-74 and 17-88, is hereby further
amended to read as follows:

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1 be deemed to come from funds available under the amended 2 Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt of 3 Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended 4 Compact from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be 5 deemed to come from funds available under the amended 6 Compact from the private sector development sector; 7 8 \$222,450 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the enhanced reporting 9 and accountability sector; and \$1,153,025 shall be 10 11 deemed to come from funds available under the amended 12 Compact from the infrastructure sector."
