#### PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-62

#### AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$1,294,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, by amending sections 1, 2, 3 and 8 and of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-26, 18-41 and 18-54, to correct technical errors, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 2 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by 3 Public Laws Nos. 18-26, 18-41 and 18-54, is hereby further 4 amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Title. The title of this act is as 5 follows: To appropriate the sum of \$58,784,711 from the 6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for 7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, for the 8 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the 9 National Government of the Federated States of 10 11 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, 12 subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development. Of the total amount of funds 13 14 appropriated herein, \$2,437,568 shall be deemed to come 15 from funds available under the Amended Compact from the education sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from 16 17 funds available under the Amended Compact from the health sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds 18 19 available under the Amended Compact from the

infrastructure sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from 1 2 funds available under the Amended Compact from the public sector capacity building; \$-0- shall be deemed to 3 come from funds available under the Amended Compact from 4 5 the enhanced reporting and accountability sector; and \$1,112,158 shall be deemed to come from funds available 6 7 under the Supplemental Education Grant. The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:" 8 9 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by 10 Public Laws Nos. 18-41 and 18-54, is hereby amended to read as 11 follows:
