AN ACT

To further amend chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by creating a new subchapter III of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), and for other purposes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated 1 States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by 2 creating a new subchapter III entitled: "Code of the FSM 3 (Annotated)". 4 Section 2. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated 5 States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by 6 adding a new section 251 to subchapter III, to read as follows: 7 "Section 251. Code of the Federated States of 8 9 Micronesia (Annotated); Statement of Intent. This section is intended to effect a codification of the 10 11 general and permanent National laws of the Federated States of Micronesia and is not intended to effect any 12 substantive changes therein." 13 14 Section 3. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by 15 adding a new section 252 to subchapter III, to read as follows: 16 17 "Section 252. Designation of code. The attached manuscript is incorporated by reference herein and is 18

hereby designated as the "Code of the Federated States 1 2 of Micronesia (Annotated)". This code contains the 3 general and permanent National laws of the Federated States of Micronesia and is prepared under the authority 4 5 of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia." Section 4. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated 6 7 States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new section 253 to subchapter III, to read as follows: 8 9 "Section 253. Adoption as positive law. All enacted law of the Congress of the Federated 10 (1)11 States of Micronesia as adopted and enacted in subchapter II of chapter 2 of title 1 of this code and 12 all enacted general and permanent National laws of the 13 14 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia through the end of the 17th Congress of the Federated States of 15 Micronesia which are incorporated as part II of the 16 attached manuscript are hereby readopted and reenacted 17 as positive law of the Federated States of Micronesia in 18 the form appearing in the manuscript. 19 20 The tables of contents, sources, cross-references, (2)editor's notes, and errata are not to be construed as an 21 22 adoption of those citations and resources, and these are included in the code as additional tools for research 23 and are for reference purposes only. 24

25 (3) All code sections that are designated as included

2	additional tools for research and are not readopted and
3	reenacted.
4	(4) All enacted law which are readopted and reenacted
5	pursuant to subsection (1) of this section are hereby
6	repealed in its prior form."
7	Section 5. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated
8	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by
9	adding a new section 254 to subchapter III, to read as follows:
10	"Section 254. Other documents not adopted. The
11	inclusion in parts I, III, and IV relating to the
12	Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia, the
13	Government of the Trust Territory of the Pacific
14	Islands, the state constitutions, the cross-reference
15	table(s), and the index are not a part of the code and
16	are not to be construed as an adoption of these
17	documents and are included in the code for reference
18	purposes only and to add additional resources and tools
19	for research."
20	Section 6. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated
21	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by
22	adding a new section 255 to subchapter III, to read as follows:
23	"Section 255. Laws unaffected. Nothing in this Act
24	offorta the volidity of either envropriation laws other

24 affects the validity of either appropriation laws, other 25 temporary National laws not included in this code, or

1	laws enacted after the Seventeenth Congress of the
2	Federated States of Micronesia."
3	Section 7. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated
4	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by
5	adding a new section 256 to subchapter III, to read as follows:
6	"Section 256. <u>Rights and liabilities unaffected</u> . The
7	repeal in subsection (4) of section 253 of this
8	subchapter does not affect the status of any civil or
9	criminal actions, rights, or liabilities existing before
10	the repeal takes effect."
11	Section 8. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated
12	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by
13	adding a new section 257 to subchapter III, to read as follows:
14	"Section 257. <u>Government authority unaffected</u> . The
15	republication in this code of Trust Territory laws and
16	the retention of any references therein to the authority
17	of the Government of the Trust Territory of the Pacific
18	Islands are not intended to alter, diminish, or in any
19	way change or affect the authority of the National
20	Government or the respective State governments of the
21	Federated States of Micronesia over the subject of
22	legislation included therein, as that authority has been
23	established by the Constitution of the Federated States
24	of Micronesia, the State constitutions, and other
25	applicable law."

1	Section 9. Chapter 2 title 1 of the Code of the Federated
2	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by
3	adding a new section 258 to subchapter III, to read as follows:
4	"Section 258. <u>State law reaffirmed</u> . The authority of
5	the States of the Federated States of Micronesia with
6	regard to those provisions of the Trust Territory Code
7	within the jurisdiction of the States is unaffected and
8	hereby reaffirmed."
9	Section 10. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the
10	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further
11	amended by adding a new section 259 to subchapter III, to read as
12	follows:
13	"Section 259. <u>Technical amendments to the laws</u> .
14	Technical amendments to the laws included in part II of
15	this code, whether or not those laws are readopted and
16	reenacted pursuant to section 253 of this subchapter,
17	are hereby enacted regarding the following:
18	(1) organization, numbering, and references to titles,
19	chapters, subchapters, parts, sections, subsections, and
20	other subparts;
21	(2) changes in phraseology;
22	(3) changes in introductory materials; and
23	(4) correction of typographical, grammatical, or other
24	errors."
25	Section 11. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the

Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further 1 2 amended by adding a new section 260 to subchapter III, to read as 3 follows: "Section 260. Future amendments; citations. 4 Future amendments to laws included in part II of 5 (1)this code, whether or not those laws are readopted and 6 7 reenacted pursuant to section 253 of this subchapter, 8 shall be made with reference to such laws as they appear 9 in this code. (2) The preferred citation of laws included in part II 10 of this code is as follows: first, the title number in 11 Arabic numerals; second, 'F.S.M.C.'; and third, section 12 number. Example: The citation of section 201, 13 14 'Qualifications of Senators,' of title 9, 'National 15 Elections,' would appear as `9 F.S.M.C. 201'." Section 12. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the 16 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further 17 amended by adding a new section 261 to subchapter III, to read as 18 follows: 19 20 "Section 261. Supplements as part of code. (1) The laws contained in any current pocket parts or 21 22 supplements to this code, printed and published under 23 contract or otherwise as may be authorized by law, constitute prima facie a part of this code if the laws, 24 25 as so contained, purport to represent reproductions of

statutory amendments to this code, as stated in
 accompanying notes thereto.

3 (2) If pocket parts or supplements are published on a 4 cumulative basis, then only the laws in the latest 5 publication thereof constitute *prima facie* a part of 6 this code.

7 (3) If any discrepancy arises between the text of a
8 provision set out in the current supplement and that
9 contained in the basic Act as separately printed and
10 published by the President of the Federated States of
11 Micronesia or his designee pursuant to the authority
12 granted by law, the latter shall constitute the positive
13 law and shall control."

14 Section 13. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the 15 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further 16 amended by adding a new section 262 to subchapter III, to read as 17 follows:

18 "Section 262. <u>Repealer</u>. The Trust Territory Code to 19 the extent it is not republished herein or reaffirmed as 20 within the jurisdiction of the States by sections 257 21 and 258 of this subchapter are hereby repealed in its 22 entirety."

23 Section 14. Chapter 2 title 1 of the Code of the Federated 24 States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by 25 adding a new section 263 to subchapter III, to read as follows:

1	"Section 263. Authorization for publication of
2	<u>F.S.M.C.</u> . The publishing of the official edition of the
3	Code of the Federated States of Micronesia 2014 edition
4	(Annotated) (F.S.M.C.), pursuant to contract with the
5	Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby
6	authorized."
7	Section 15. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the
8	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further
9	amended by adding a new section 264 to subchapter III, to read as
10	follows:
11	"Section 264. <u>Contents of F.S.M.C.</u> . The Code of the
12	Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated) shall contain
13	the general and permanent National laws codified as
14	positive law in the F.S.M.C. pursuant to
15	sections 251 through 265 of this subchapter III of this
16	chapter, supplemented and updated with any amendments or
17	additions to the law requiring codification through the
18	end of the Seventeenth Congress of the Federated States
19	of Micronesia."
20	Section 16. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the
21	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further
22	amended by adding a new section 265 to subchapter III, to read as
23	follows:

24 "Section 265. <u>Laws unaffected by earlier publication</u>.
25 The supplementing and updating to the original 1982

1	F.S.M.C. in the First Supplement authorized by Public
2	Law No. 4-33, any subsequent codifications, and in this
3	codification with subsequently enacted general and
4	permanent National laws, shall not effect any
5	substantive change to the law as enacted and as it
6	became effective."
7	Section 17. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9	becoming law without such approval.
