A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$76,615,687 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, to provide funding for the operation of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions, capital improvement projects, and other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Title. The title of this act is as follows: To  
2 appropriate the sum of \$76,615,687 from the General Fund of the  
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
4 September 30, 2016, for the purpose of funding the operation of  
5 all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of  
6 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and  
7 contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development. Of the  
8 total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$1,000,000 shall be  
9 deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from  
10 education sector; and \$1,056,546 shall be deemed to come from  
11 funds available under the Supplemental Education Grant. The sum  
12 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:

13           Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The  
14 sum of \$18,677,295, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is  
15 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States  
16 of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for  
17 the purpose of funding the operations of the Executive Branch of  
18 the National Government during the fiscal year 2016. Of the total

1 amount of funds appropriated herein, \$366,598 shall be deemed to  
 2 come from funds available under the Supplemental Education Grant.

17           Section 11. Reprogramming. Reprogramming of funds into or  
 18 from the personnel budget line item shall not be permitted. The  
 19 President, Speaker and Chief Justice may reprogram up to 10  
 20 percent to or from the funds appropriated in sections 2 (Operating  
 21 expenses of the Executive Branch), 3 (Operating expenses of the  
 22 Legislative Branch), and 4 (Operating expenses of the National  
 23 Judicial Branch). Reprogramming of funds within a department,  
 24 office or agency shall be effected by the head of such department,  
 25 office or agency by specifying in writing to the Secretary of the

---

1 Department of Finance and Administration of the FSM National  
2 Government, the accounts for which funding is either increased or  
3 decreased. Reprogramming other than as specified herein is not  
4 permitted, and more specifically, reprogramming into or out of any  
5 line item contained in section 8 (Grants, Subsidies and  
6 Contributions) or section 9 (Investment: Capital and Human  
7 Resources) is not permitted. The President shall report to  
8 Congress within one month of the last day of each financial  
9 quarter all amounts reprogrammed inter or intra a department,  
10 office or agency.

11 Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
12 dates.

13 (1) General provisions.

14 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
15 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance  
16 with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial  
17 Management Act of 1979.

18 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring  
19 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
20 solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no  
21 obligations are incurred in excess of the sums appropriated.

22 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds appropriated by  
23 this act are as follows:

24 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall be  
25 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

1 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall be  
2 the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia;

3 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall be  
4 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated States of  
5 Micronesia;

6 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall be  
7 the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia;

8 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these  
9 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of  
10 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following subsections  
11 of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

12 (i) Section 8, subsection (12)(a) through (d) -  
13 the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the  
14 respective State Supreme Court;

15 (ii) Section 8(12)(e) - the allottee shall be the  
16 President of the College of Micronesia - FSM;

17 (iii) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) - the allottee  
18 of these funds shall be the President of the College of  
19 Micronesia-FSM; and

20 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to  
21 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of  
22 September 30, 2016; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds appropriated  
23 under section 9 of this act shall not lapse.

1           Section 13. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
