

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 18-117, by amending sections 2, 3, 4, and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people in each of the four states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-117 is hereby
