

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-18, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-24, 16-32, 16-39, 16-45, 16-54, 16-67, 17-04, 17-14, 17-26, 17-39 and 17-65, by amending section 1 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-18, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 16-24, 16-32, 16-39, 16-45, 16-54, 16-67,
3 17-04, 17-14, 17-26, 17-39 and 17-65, is hereby further amended
4 to read as follows:

5 "Section 1. The sum of \$3,301,000, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
7 from the General Fund of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
9 2010, for the purpose of funding Economic and Social
10 Projects and Programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae,
11 Pohnpei and Chuuk. The funds appropriated under this
12 section shall be apportioned as follows:
