

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting the "Strategic Prevention Framework State Incentive Grant (SPF-SIG) Micronesia-No Cost Extension" Notice of Award in the amount of \$1,276,606 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, to fund the FSM Department of Health and Social Affairs to continue SPF-SIG Micronesia Funding extending the five (5) year term per C.R. No. 16-42 (2009 to 2014) to a six (6) year term (2009-2015).

1 WHEREAS, the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services
2 Agency of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services
3 issued a program announcement regarding availability to funds
4 to support projects in the area of substance abuse and mental
5 health services for the purpose of preventing and/or reducing
6 the progression of under age alcohol consumption among the
7 youth in the FSM; and

8 WHEREAS, upon reviewing the scope, purpose, and
9 eligibility contained in the program announcement, the funding
10 available in this program can be of benefit to the FSM,
11 particularly the youth of the Nation; and

12 WHEREAS, section 210(2) of title 55 of the Code of the
13 Federated States of Micronesia provides that for an agreement
14 on foreign financial assistance to be valid it must be approved
15 by Congress by resolution; and

16 WHEREAS, the FSM Government expresses appreciation to the
17 United States Government for the federal grant programs made
18 available to the Federated States of Micronesia; now,

1 therefore,

2 BE IT RESOLVED by the Eighteenth Congress of the Federated
3 States of Micronesia, Fourth Special Session, 2014, that
4 Congress hereby approves and accepts the Notice of Award
5 "Strategic Prevention Framework State Incentive Grant (SPF-SIG)
6 Micronesia-No Cost Extension (NCE)" in the amount of
7 \$1,278,606, and extending the terms per C.R. No. 16-42 from
8 five to six years (2009-2015); and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
10 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated
11 States of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of Health
12 and Social Affairs, and the United States Embassy in Kolonia.
