A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, 18-116, 19-02, 19-09, 19-27, 19-28 and 19-31, by amending section 9 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended 2 by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, 18-116, 19-02, 19-09, 19-27 and 19-31, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 3 4 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development. 5 The sum of \$56,260,976 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General 6 7 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, for the 8 9 following capital improvements, development programs, 10 and projects and human resources development. Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$1,700,000 11 shall be deemed to come from funds available under 12 the Compact Sector Grant for COM-FSM, and \$683,346 13 14 shall be available from the Supplemental Education 15 Grant, and \$282,339 will be available from amended Compact carry-over funds. The sum appropriated by 16 this section shall be apportioned as follows: 17 18 (1) College of Micronesia - FSM.
