A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget in the amount of \$2,732,733 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, by amending sections 1 and 9 of Public Law No. 19-32, as amended by Public Laws No. 19-45, 19-61, and 19-83, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-32, as amended by

2 Public Laws Nos. 19-45, 19-61, and 19-83, is hereby further

3 amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is as 4 5 follows: To appropriate the sum of $\{\$79,917,215\}$ \$82,649,948 from the General Fund of the Federated 6 7 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the purpose of funding the 8 9 operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, 10 various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions 11 12 and Capital and Human Resources Development. 13 National Government's share of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero except that the National 14 15 Government will retain 10 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in the budget for 16 17 the Department of Education. The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:" 18

1 Section 2. Section 9 of Public Law No. 19-32, as amended by 2 Public Law No. 19-83, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 4 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development. 5 The sum of \$38,303,498 [\$41,036,231], or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the 6 7 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the 8 9 following capital improvements, development programs, and projects and human resources development. 10 total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$689,598 11 12 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the 13 Amended Compact from the Supplemental Education Grant.
