A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, 18-116, 19-02 and 19-09, by amending sections 9 and 13 thereof, to change the use and allotee of funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, 18-116, 19-02 and 19-09, is
- 3 hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources
- 5 Development. The sum of \$60,142,645 or so much
- 6 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
- 7 from the General Fund of the Federated States of
- 8 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
- 9 2015, for the following capital improvements,
- development programs, and projects and human
- 11 resources development. Of the total amount of
- funds appropriated herein, \$1,700,000 shall be
- deemed to come from funds available under the
- 14 Compact Sector Grant for COM-FSM, and \$683,346
- shall be available from the Supplemental Education
- 16 Grant, and \$282,339 will be available from amended
- 17 Compact carry-over funds. The sum appropriated by
- this section shall be apportioned as follows:

14	Section 2. Section 13 of Public Law No. 18-89, as
15	amended by Public Law No. 19-09, is hereby further amended to
16	read as follows:
17	"Section 13. Allotment and management of funds and
18	lapse dates.
19	(1) General provisions.
20	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
21	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
22	accordance with applicable law, including, but not
23	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
24	(b) The allottees shall be responsible for
25	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be

necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in 1 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess 2 of the sums appropriated. 3 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds 4 5 appropriated by this act are as follows: (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds 6 7 shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia; 8 9 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds 10 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated 11 States of Micronesia; (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds 12 13 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the 14 Federated States of Micronesia; 15 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of 16 17 Micronesia; 18 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the Federated States of 19 20 Micronesia; PROVIDED HOWEVER, that for the following 21 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act: 22 (i) Section 8(6)(q) - the allottee shall be 23 the President of the College of Micronesia - FSM; and (ii) Section 8, (13)(a) through (d) - the 24 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of 25

1	the respective State Supreme Court;
2	(iii) Section 8 (10)(a) through (i) <u>and</u>
3	$\underline{\text{section 9(14)(p)}}$ - the allottee of these funds shall be
4	the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
5	Micronesia; and
6	(iv) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) - the
7	allottee of these funds shall be the President of the
8	College of Micronesia-FSM.
9	(v) Section 9(4)(g)-the allottee of these
10	funds shall be the Governor of Chuuk State.
11	(vi) Section 9(4)(i)-the allottee of these
12	funds shall be the Governor of Yap State.
13	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
14	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
15	of September 30, 2015; PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the funds
16	appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not lapse
17	and the funds appropriated under sections $8(4)$ $(r)-(y)$
18	shall not lapse until September 30, 2016."
19	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
20	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
21	becoming law without such approval.
