A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, 18-116, 19-02, 19-09, 19-27, and 19-28, by amending sections 1 and 9 thereof, to deapproriate funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended
- 2 by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, 18-116, 19-02, and 19-09,
- 3 is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
- 5 appropriate the sum of [\$99,046,644] \$94,796,644 from
- 6 the General Fund of the Federated States of
- 7 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
- 8 2015, for the purpose of funding the operations of
- 9 all branches of the National Government of the
- 10 Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various
- 11 programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and
- 12 Capital and Human Resources Development. The
- 13 National Government's share of the Amended Compact
- 14 funds has been reduced to zero except that the
- 15 National Government will retain ten percent (10%) of
- 16 the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is
- 17 reflected in the budget for the Department of
- 18 Education. The budget shall also include

appropriations for COM-FSM from sector grants as well 1 2 as appropriations from amended Compact carry-over 3 funds." 4 Section 2. Section 9 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, 18-116, 19-02, 19-09, and 5 19-27, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 6 7 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development. 8 The sum of [\$60,142,645] \$55,892,645 or so much 9 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated 10 from the General Fund of the Federated States of 11 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, for the following capital improvements, 12 13 development programs, and projects and human 14 resources development. Of the total amount of funds 15 appropriated herein, \$1,700,000 shall be deemed to 16 come from funds available under the Compact Sector 17 Grant for COM-FSM, and \$683,346 shall be available 18 from the Supplemental Education Grant, and \$282,339 19 will be available from amended Compact carry-over The sum appropriated by this section shall be 20 21 apportioned as follows: 22 (1) College of Micronesia - FSM. 23 (a) College of Micronesia—FSM \$ 3,800,000 24 (\$1,700,000 shall come from the Compact 25 Sector Grant)
