A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the Supplemental Education Grant (SEG) grant award in the amount of \$556,074 for the data management initiative under the Department of Education, to appropriate \$1,900,000 Tourism Matching Investment from the Private Sector Development Grant under the Amended Compact, to introduce a technical amendment to the appropriation of the SEG grant to the COM-FSM in the FY16 Budget by amending sections 1, 2 and 9 of Public Law No. 19-32, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
