A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend title 11 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), by creating a new chapter 13 to grant the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia the power to expunge the record of a person accused or convicted of a national crime, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Title 11 of the Code of the Federated States of 2 Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by creating a new chapter 13 entitled: "Expungement". 3 Section 2. Title 11 of the Code of the Federated States of 4 Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by inserting a new 5 6 section 1301 to chapter 13, to read as follows: 7 "Section 1301. Purpose. 8 The purpose of this chapter is to grant the Supreme 9 Court of the Federated States of Micronesia the power to expunge the record of a person accused or convicted 10 11 of a national crime." 12 Section 3. Title 11 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by inserting a new 13 section 1302 in chapter 13, to read as follows: 14

(1) The Supreme Court of the Federated States of

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1 there is an extreme need or exceptional circumstance 2 that warrants expungement. (2) An order entered pursuant to subsection (1) of 3 this section shall expunge from all official records 4 all recordation relating to the person's arrest, 5 indictment or information, trial, finding of guilt, and 6 7 sentencing. The effect of such order shall be to restore the person, in the contemplation of the law, to 8 9 the status he occupied before such arrest or indictment or information. No person as to whom such order has 10 been entered shall be held thereafter under any 11 12 provisions of any law to be guilty of perjury or 13 otherwise giving a false statement by reason of his 14 failures to recite or acknowledge such arrest, or 15 indictment or information, or trial, or sentence in 16 response to any inquiry made of him for any purpose."
