AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 19-152, by amending sections 2, 3, 5 and 6 $\,$ thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, and Chuuk, and for other purposes.
