23	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
24	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
25	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in

accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum The allottee of the funds appropriated appropriated. under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 2(i) shall be the President of COM-FSM. The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3(a)(b)(c)(d)(e)(f)(g)(h)(i)(j)(k)(l) and (m) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allotte of funds appropriation under sections 4(3)(a) and 4(3)(f) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Meninkeden Lapalap of Madolenimw and the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(3)(i) of this act shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of section 5 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee.

Development Authority. The allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection 5(4) of section 5 of this
act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 5(5) of section 5 of this act shall be the
Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act to
the States of Chuuk, Kosrae and Pohnpei shall lapse on
September 30, 2016. All funds appropriated to Yap State
that are not allotted by May 1, 2016, shall be deposited
into the Yap State Trust Fund. The allottee of the
funds appropriated under section 2 of this act for Yap
State shall report proof of deposit to Congress of the
Federated States of Micronesia within 30 days from
depositing funds into the Yap State Trust Fund."
