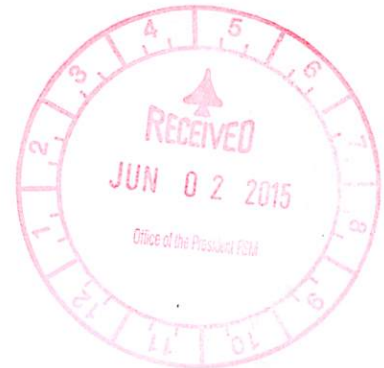

PUBLIC LAW No. 19-05

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113 and 18-121, by amending sections 4, 5, and 6 thereof, to change the use, allottee and lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the States of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 18-113 and 18-121, is hereby amended to read as
3 follow:

6 programs for the people of the State of Pohnpei.

 25 Public Laws Nos. 18-113 and 18-121, is hereby further amended to

2 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
3 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
4 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
5 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
6 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
7 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
8 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
9 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
10 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
11 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
12 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
13 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
14 appropriated under section 3 shall be the President or
15 his designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds
16 appropriated under section 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e),
17 (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o) and (u)
18 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government. The
19 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this
20 act shall be the President or his designee, EXCEPT that
21 the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(a)
22 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education;
23 the allottee of funds appropriated under section
24 4(1)(c), (e), and (h) shall be Secretary of the
25 Department of Transportation, Communications and

1 Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated under
2 section 4(1)(d) shall be the Pohnpei Port Authority; the
3 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(f)
4 shall be the Nett District Government; the allottee of
5 funds appropriated under section 4(1)(g) shall be the
6 Secretary of the Department of Resources and
7 Development; the allottee of funds appropriated under
8 section 4(2)(b) shall be the Mayor of Kapinga Municipal
9 Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under
10 sections 4(3)(b) and 4(4)(a) shall be the Pohnpei
11 Transportation Authority and the allottee of funds
12 appropriated under section 4(3)(g) shall be the COM-FSM
13 Cooperative Extension Service. The allottee of funds
14 appropriated under sections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this
15 act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
16 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
17 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock
18 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
19 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
20 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
21 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of
22 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
23 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
24 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
25 2016."
