AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-130 and 19-142, by amending sections 4 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.
