Dear Speaker Simina:

I am transmitting the following congressional act, which I signed to become Public Law No. 19-172:

Congressional Act No. 19-178: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 101, 102, 103, 106, 107 AND 108 OF TITLE 18 OF THE CODE OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA (ANNOTATED) AND INSERTING NEW SECTIONS 102A, 105A, 105B, 105C AND 107A SECTIONS TO ESTABLISH ADDITIONAL MARITIME ZONES, EXTENSION OF CONTINENTAL SHELF AND BASELINES AS RECOGNIZED BY THE LAW OF THE SEA CONVENTION, TO BRING TITLE 18 IN CONFORMITY CONTEMPORARY NORMS AND PRACTICES UNDER INTERNATIONAL LAW, TO INCORPORATE TREATY OBLIGATIONS ASSUMED BY THE **MICRONESIA** SUCH AS **MARITIME FEDERATED** STATES OF WITH **NEIGHBORING BOUNDARY** DELIMITATION **TREATIES** NATIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

This act amends several sections of title 18 of the FSM Code, and as indicated on its title, it establishes additional maritime zones and baselines of FSM and extension of continental shelf.

I wish to extend our appreciation to the 19th Congress for the passage of this act. Thank you.





#### AN ACT

To amend sections 101, 102, 103, 106, 107 and 108 of title 18 of the code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated) and inserting new sections 102A, 105A, 105B, 105C and 107A sections to establish additional maritime zones, extension of continental shelf and baselines as recognized by the Law of the Sea Convention, to bring title 18 in conformity with contemporary norms and practices under international law, to incorporate treaty obligations assumed by the Federated States of Micronesia such as maritime boundary delimitation treaties with neighboring nations, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 101 of title 18 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "Section 101. Baseline system defined.
- 5 (1) A baseline is a continuous line which encircles
- an island or an atoll. The baseline from which the
- 7 zones designated in this Chapter are to be measured is
- 8 as follows:
- 9 (a) The baseline of an island or portion of an
- 10 island lacking a barrier reef, fringing reef, or other
- reef system is the low-water line of the island drawn by
- reference to lists of geographical coordinates expressed
- in terms of the geodetic datum or as marked on large-
- 14 scale charts officially recognized by the government of
- the Federated States of Micronesia.
- 16 (b) The baseline of an atoll or island or

portion of an island having a barrier reef, fringing
reef, or other reef system is a line following the
contour of the seaward edge of the reef system, which
line connects those outermost elevations of the reef
which are above water at low-water drawn by reference to
lists of geographical coordinates expressed in terms of
the geodetic datum or as marked on large-scale charts
officially recognized by the government of the Federated
States of Micronesia.

- (c) Where there are breaks in reefs, entrances to lagoons, river mouths or bays, the President may make regulations declaring the geographic coordinates of the natural entrance points of low water between closing lines are drawn.
- (2) Baselines may be comprised of straight archipelagic baselines joining the outermost points of the outermost islands and drying reefs of the archipelago.
- (3) The baselines from which the breadth of the Territorial Sea, contiguous zone, exclusive economic zone and continental shelf of the Federated States of Micronesia are those defined and described in Schedule 1 and include points between which archipelagic baselines or closing baselines are drawn. The President shall officially declare the incorporation of Schedule 1 to

1	this section, and he may, from time to time, by
2	executive proclamation, provide update on any of the
3	contents of Schedule 1.
4	(4) A baseline established or recognized under this
5	title may be used to generate the zones of the Federated
6	States of Micronesia and may be used to establish the
7	outer limit of continental shelf or as a constraint line
8	of any extension thereof.
9	Section 2. Section 102 of title 18 of the Code of the
LO	Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended to
L 1	read as follows:
L <b>2</b>	"Section 102. Territorial Sea and internal waters -
L 3	Defined.
L <b>4</b>	(1) There is hereby established a Territorial Sea of
15	12 nautical miles (M) breadth. The inner boundary of
۱6	the Territorial Sea of each island or atoll is the
L 7	baseline as defined in Section 101 of this Title. The
18	outer boundary is a line, every point of which is 12 M
۱9	seaward of the nearest point of the baseline.
20	(2) Waters landward of the baseline, including the
21	lagoons of atolls or islands, are internal waters.
22	Section 3. Title 18 of the Code of the Federated States of
23	Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by inserting new section
24	102A at the end of section 102 of chapter 1 to read as follows:
25	"Section 102A. Archipelagic water - Defined.

1	(1) Waters, other than internal waters, landward of				
2	the archipelagic baselines declared under subsection (2)				
3	of this section are archipelagic waters.				
4	(2) The President of the Federated States of				
5	Micronesia may from time to time declare, in accordance				
6	with international law, the geographic coordinates of				
7	points between which archipelagic baselines are to be				
8	drawn.				
9	Section 4. Section 103 of title 18 of the Code of the				
10	Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended to				
11	1 read as follows:				
12	"Section 103. Territorial Sea, archipelagic waters, and				
13	internal waters - Sovereignty.				
14	The sovereignty of the Federated States of Micronesia				
15	extends to its internal waters, archipelagic waters, and				
16	Territorial Sea, including sovereign rights over the				
17	living and nonliving resources in the Territorial Sea				
18	and internal waters and in the airspace above the				
19	Territorial Sea, archipelagic waters, and internal				
20	waters as well as the seabed and subsoil."				
21	Section 5. Section 104 of title 18 of the Code of the				
22	Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended to				
23	read as follows:				
24	"Section 104. Exclusive economic zone - Defined.				
2 E	Thora is hareby established an exclusive economic zone				

1	contiguous to the Territorial Sea. The inner boundary of			
2	the exclusive economic zone of each island or atoll is			
3	the seaward boundary of the Territorial Sea, and the			
4	outer boundary is a line, every point of which is not			
5	more than 200 M seaward of the nearest point on the			
6	baseline as defined in section 101 of this Title."			
7	Section 6. Title 18 of the Code of the Federated States of			
8	Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by inserting new			
9	section 105A at the end of section 105 of chapter 1 to read as			
10	follows:			
11	"Section 105A. Contiguous Zone.			
12	(1) There is hereby established a Contiguous Zone,			
13	comprising those areas of the sea that are beyond and			
14	adjacent to the Territorial Sea. The inner boundary of			
15	the contiguous zone is the seaward boundary of the			
16	Territorial Sea. The outer boundary of the Contiguous			
17	Zone is a line, every point of which is not more than 24			
18	M seaward of the nearest point of the baseline as			
19	defined in section 101 of this title.			
20	(2) The President may, from time to time, by			
21	Proclamation, declare the limits of the whole or of any			
22	part of the contiguous zone of the Federated States of			
23	Micronesia.			
24	(3) Within the Contiguous Zone, the National			
25	Government of the Federated States of Micronesia may			

1	exercise the control necessary to:
2	(a) prevent infringement of its customs, fiscal,
3	immigration or sanitary laws and regulations within the
4	territory of the Federated States of Micronesia or the
5	Territorial Sea; and
6	(b) punish infringement of its customs, fiscal,
7	immigration or sanitary laws and regulations committed
8	within the territory of the Federated States of
9	Micronesia or the territorial sea."
10	Section 7. Title 18 of the Code of the Federated States of
11	Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by inserting new section
12	105B at the end of section 105A of chapter 1 to read as follows:
13	"Section 105B. Continental Shelf.
14	(1) There is hereby established a Continental Shelf
15	comprising of the seabed and subsoil of the submarine
16	areas that extend beyond the Territorial Sea throughout
17	the natural prolongation of the land territory to the
18	outer edge of the continental margin, or to a distance
19	of 200 M from the baselines from which the breadth of
20	the Territorial Sea is measured where the outer edge of
21	the continental margin does not extend up to that
22	distance.
23	(2) Subject to subsection (3) of this section and any
24	relevant international agreement to which the Federated
25	States of Micronesia is a party:

1	(a) the inner boundary of the Continental Shelf
2	is the seaward boundary of the Territorial Sea; and
3	(b) the outer boundary of the Continental Shelf
4	is a line, every point of which is not more than 200 M
5	seaward of the nearest point on the baseline as defined
6	in section 101 of this title.
7	(3) Where the continental shelf is beyond 200 M, it
8	shall not extend more than 350 M from any of the
9	baselines recognized under Schedule 1 from which the
10	breadth of the Territorial Sea is measured."
11	Section 8. Title 18 of the Code of the Federated States of
12	Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by inserting new section
13	105C at the end of section 105B of chapter 1 to read as follows:
14	"Section 105C. Extension of Continental Shelf.
15	Whenever the continental margin extends beyond 200 M
16	from the baselines as defined in section 101, the outer
17	limits of the continental shelf are to be established in
18	accordance with Article 76 of the Convention."
19	Section 9. Title 18 of the Code of the Federated States of
20	Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by inserting new section
21	105D at the end of section 105C of chapter 1 to read as follows:
22	"Section 105D. Rights and jurisdiction over the
23	Continental Shelf.
24	Within the Continental Shelf, the National Government of
25	the Federated States of Micronesia shall have:

1	(a) sovereign rights for the purpose of			
2	exploring the continental shelf and exploiting its			
3	natural resources,			
4	(b) exclusive rights to authorize and regulate			
5	drilling on the continental shelf for all purposes,			
6	(c) exclusive rights to construct, authorize and			
7	regulate the construction, operation and use of			
8	artificial islands, installations and structures,			
9	(d) jurisdiction with respect to protection and			
10	preservation of the marine environment, and			
11	(e) the right to regulate, authorize and conduct			
12	marine scientific research."			
13	Section 10. Section 106 of title 18 of the Code of the			
14	Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended to			
15	read as follows:			
16	"Section 106. Submerged reefs.			
17	Traditionally recognized fishing rights in submerged			
18	reef areas wherever located within the fishery zones of			
19	Micronesia shall be preserve and respected."			
20	Section 11. Section 107 of title 18 of the Code of the			
21	Federated States of Micronesia ((Annotated), is hereby amended to			
22	read as follows:			
23	"Section 107. Regulations.			
24	The President of the Federated States of Micronesia may			
25	issue such regulations as are necessary to establish the			

1	baselines, the boundaries of internal waters, the			
2	archipelagic waters, the Territorial Sea, the exclusive			
3	economic zone, the Contiguous Zone, and the Continental			
4	Shelf."			
5	Section 12. Title 18 of the Code of the Federated States of			
6	Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by inserting new section			
7	7 107A at the end of section 107 of chapter 1 to read as follows:			
8	"Section 107A. Production of charts.			
9	The President may cause to be prepared such charts as he			
10	deems fit showing the baselines or the zones, or any			
11	matter relating thereto. Such charts when certified by			
12	the President or his designee constitute a prima facie			
13	evidence of any matter shown thereon."			
14	Section 13. Section 108 of title 18 of the Code of the			
15	Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended to			
16	read as follows:			
17	"Section 108. Definitions.			
18	As used in this Chapter:			
19	(1) "Archipelago" means a group of islands, including			
20	parts of islands, interconnecting waters and other			
21	natural features which are so closely interrelated that			
22	such islands, waters and other natural features form an			
23	intrinsic geographical, economic and political entity,			
24	or which historically have been regarded as such.			
25	(2) "Atoll" means a naturally formed reef system			

which has one or more islands situated on the reef system, including Ngulu, Ulithi, Sorol, Eauripik, Woleai, Faraulep, Ifalik, Olimarao, Elato, Lamotrek, West Fayu, Puluwat, Pulap, Pulusuk, Namonuito, Kuop, Nomowin, Murilo, Losap, Namoluk, Satawan, Etal, Lukunor, Minto Reef, Oroluk, Nukuoro, Kapingamarangi, Pakin, Ant, Sapwuafik, Mwoakilloa, and Pingelap.

- established under section 105B. It comprises the seabed and subsoil of the submarine areas that extend beyond the Territorial Sea throughout the natural prolongation of land territory to the outer edge of the continental margin, or to a distance of 200 M from the baselines from which the breadth of the Territorial Sea is measured where the outer edge of the continental margin does not extend up to that distance. The Continental Shelf may, in accordance with section 105C, extend beyond the 200 M from the baselines in accordance with the limits recognized by the Convention. For the purpose of this section, the term "continental margin" shall have the same interpretation as understood under the Convention.
- (4) "Convention" means the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea.
  - (5) "Geodetic datum" means the World Geodetic System

1	1984 (WGS84).
2	(6) "Island" means a naturally formed area of land,
3	surrounded by water, which is above water at high tide.
4	(7) "Low-water" means the Lowest Astronomical Tide.
5	(8) "Low-tide" has a corresponding meaning.
6	(9) "Mile" or "M" means the international nautical
7	mile, equivalent to 1,852 meters.
8	(10) "Straight line" means geodesic.
9	(11) "Territorial Sea" means the territorial sea of
10	the Federated States of Micronesia.
11	(12) "Zones" means the different maritime zones
12	recognized in the Convention, namely: the territorial
13	sea, the contiguous zone, the exclusive economic zone,
14	and the continental shelf."

1	Section 14.	This act	shall become law upon approval by the
2	President of the	Federated	States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
3	law without such	approval.
