## AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, 18-116, 19-02 and 19-09, by amending sections 4, 8, 9 and 13 thereof, to change the use and allotee of funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

9	hereby further amended to read as follows:
10	"Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.
11	The sum of \$60,142,645 or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
13	of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
14	year ending September 30, 2015, for the following
15	capital improvements, development programs, and projects
16	and human resources development. Of the total amount of
17	funds appropriated herein, \$1,700,000 shall be deemed to
18	come from funds available under the Compact Sector Grant
19	for COM-FSM, and \$683,346 shall be available from the
20	Supplemental Education Grant, and \$282,339 will be
21	available from amended Compact carry-over funds. The

22	Public Law No. 19-09, is hereby further amended to read as
23	follows:
24	"Section 13. Allotment and management of funds and
25	lapse dates.

1	(1) General provisions.
2	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
3	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
4	accordance with applicable law, including, but not
5	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
6	(b) The allottees shall be responsible for
7	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
9	this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
10	of the sums appropriated.
11	(2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
12	appropriated by this act are as follows:
13	(a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds
14	shall be the President of the Federated States of
15	Micronesia;
16	(b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds
17	shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
18	States of Micronesia;
19	(c) Section $4$ — the allottee of these funds
20	shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
21	Federated States of Micronesia;
22	(d) Section 5 — the allottee of these funds
23	shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
24	Micronesia;

(e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these

1	funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
2	Micronesia; PROVIDED HOWEVER, that for the following
3	subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:
4	(i) Section $8(6)(g)$ — the allottee shall be
5	the President of the College of Micronesia - FSM; and
6	(ii) Section 8,(13)(a) through (d) - the
7	allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
8	the respective State Supreme Court;
9	(iii) Section 8 (10)(a) through (i) and
10	section $9(14)(p)$ - the allottee of these funds shall be
11	the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
12	Micronesia; and
13	(iv) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) - the
14	allottee of these funds shall be the President of the
15	College of Micronesia-FSM.
16	(v) Section $9(4)(g)$ -the allottee of these
17	funds shall be the Governor of Chuuk State.
18	(vi) Section 9(4)(i)-the allottee of these
19	funds shall be the Governor of Yap State.
20	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
21	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
22	of September 30, 2015; PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the funds
23	appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not lapse
24	and the funds appropriated under sections $8(4)$ $(r)-(y)$
25	shall not lapse until September 30, 2016."
