PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-100

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-32, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-36, 15-44, 15-57, 15-63, 15-72, 15-78, 16-03, 16-11, 16-33, 16-46, 17-12, 17-21, 17-33, 17-40, 18-17, 18-67, 18-85, 18-104 and 19-17, by amending section 1 and 2 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and the lapse date of certain funds previously appropriated therein to fund public projects and social programs in the states of Yap and Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

12	apportioned on the basis of \$250,000 or less per member
13	of Congress as follows; PROVIDED THAT, an increase of

9	by Public Laws Nos. 15-36, 15-57, 15-63, 17-21, 17-33, 17-40,
10	18-17, 18-85 and 19-17, is hereby further amended to read as
11	follows:
12	"Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and
13	lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
14	be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for
15	in accordance with applicable laws, including, but
16	not limited to the Financial Management Acts of each
17	of the States, the Financial Management Act of 1979
18	and the amended Compact of Free Association between
19	the United States Government and the Government of
20	the Federated States of Micronesia and its related
21	agreements. The allottee shall be responsible for
22	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may
23	be necessary, are used solely for the purpose
24	specified in this act, and that no obligations are
25	incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The

1	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
2	(4)(a) of section 1 of this act shall be the Governor
3	of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of
4	funds appropriated under subsection 4(b) shall be the
5	Mortlock Islands Development Authority (MIDA). The
6	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(d)
7	of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
8	Development Authority. The allottee of fund
9	appropriated under subsection 4(e) of this act shall
10	be the Faichuk Development Authority. The allottee
11	of funds appropriated under subsections 1 and 3 of
12	section 1 of this act shall be the President of the
13	Federated States of Micronesia or his designee,
14	EXCEPT THAT the allottee of the funds appropriated
15	under subsections (1)(a), (b), (c), (d), (h), (j),
16	(1) and (m) of section 1 of this act shall be the
17	Mayor of Lelu Municipal Government. The allottee of
18	funds appropriated under subsection 4(c) of section 1
19	of this act shall be the Governor of the Chuuk State.
20	The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
21	4(f) of section 1 of this act shall be the Northwest
22	Islands Development Authority (NIDA). The allottee
23	of funds appropriated under subsection (2) of section
24	1 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of
25	Yap. The funds appropriated by this act shall lapse

1	on	September 30, 2017."
2	Section	3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
3	President of	the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
4	becoming law	without such approval.
