AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-98, 18-112, 18-122, 19-07, 19-24, 19-41, 19-52,19-73 and 19-82, by amending sections 2, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and lapse date of certain funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Chuuk State and Yap State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by

3	19-82, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

10	Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by
11	Public Laws Nos. 18-98, 18-112, 18-122 and 19-07 and 19-24, is
12	hereby further amended to read as follows:
13	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
14	lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
15	be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
16	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
17	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
18	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
19	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
20	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
21	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
22	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
23	under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
24	Yap State EXCEPT THAT the funds appropriated under
25	subsection 2(i) shall be the President of COM-FSM. The

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1	allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4
2	of this act shall be the President of the Federated
3	States of Micronesia or his designee EXCEPT THAT the
4	funds appropriated under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f,
5	g, h, i, j, k, l, m, n, o, s, t, u, v, w, x, ag, ah,
6	aj, ap and aq of section 3 this act shall be the Mayor
7	of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the funds
8	appropriated under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f and g
9	of section $4(1)$, subsections $4(3)(b)$, (c), (d), (f) and
10	(p) of this act shall the Pohnpei Transportation
11	Authority, and the funds appropriated under subsection
12	4(3)(t) shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The
13	allottee of funds appropriated under subsections $5(1)$,
14	5(3) and 5(6), of this act shall be the Governor of
15	Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds
16	appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be
17	the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The
18	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of
19	this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
20	Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
21	subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
22	Development Authority. The authority of the allottee
23	to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse
24	on September 30, 2017."
