## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-51, 19-56 and 19-72, by amending sections 2, 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the states of Yap and Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

21	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds an	<u>d</u>
22	lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act s	hall
23	be allotted, managed, administered and accounted	for
24	in accordance with applicable laws, including, bu	t not
25	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.	The

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allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 2(h) of this act shall be the President of COM-FSM. The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), 9(i), (j) and (k) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(g) and 4(2)(h) shall be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a) and 4(3)(b) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; and the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of

1	this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
2	designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
3	subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock
4	Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
5	appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall
6	be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
7	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5)
8	of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
9	Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
10	funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
11	September 30, 2017."
12	Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
13	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
14	becoming law without such approval.
