**PUBLIC LAW No. 19- 125**

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AN ACT

To amend the title and sections 1, 2, 3, 8, 9, 10 and 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, to correct for arithmetic and other technical errors, to make certain clarifications, to remove funding for certain items in response to the President's line item vetoes in the FY17 National Government Budget, to increase funding for one line item, to adjust certain totals, to add an allottee, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to amend  
2 Public Law No. 19-118, in order to correct for arithmetic and  
3 other technical errors to make certain clarifications, to remove  
4 funding for certain items in the budget in response to P.C. No.  
5 19-456, which contains the President's line item vetoes of the  
6 FY17 National Government Budget, to increase funding for one  
7 line item, and to adjust certain totals throughout the Public  
8 Law No. 19-118, accordingly:

9           Section 2. The title of Public Law No. 19-118 is hereby  
10 amended to read as follows:

11           "To appropriate \$69,800,981 from the General Fund of the  
12 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
13 September 30, 2017, to provide funding for the operations  
14 of all branches of the National Government of the  
15 Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various  
16 programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital  
17 and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes."

1       Section 3. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-118 is hereby  
2 amended to read as follows:

3       "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is as  
4 follows: To appropriate the sum of \$69,800,981 from the  
5 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the  
6 fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of  
7 funding the operations of all branches of the National  
8 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its  
9 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and  
10 contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development.  
11 The National Government's share of the Amended Compact  
12 funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT THAT, the National  
13 Government will retain 10 percent of the Supplemental  
14 Education Grant funds as is reflected in the budget for  
15 the Department of Education. The sum appropriated herein  
16 shall be apportioned as follows:"

17       Section 4. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-118 is hereby  
18 amended to read as follows:

19       "Section 2. Operating Expenses of the Executive Branch.  
20 The sum of \$18,199,317 or so much thereof as may be  
21 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of  
22 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year  
23 ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding the  
24 operations of the Executive Branch of the National  
25 Government during the fiscal year 2017. The sum

**PUBLIC LAW No. 19- 125**

3 becoming law without such approval.

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
